

### **Important Notice**

**Notice is hereby given** that the National Parks (Trading) Regulations, 2014, Statutory Instrument No.9 of 2014 and which was gazetted as Vol XXXIV No.21 dated March, 2014 will take effect on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2014.

The Regulations require that persons conducting business in the National Parks Area should hold a valid licence issued by the National Parks Authority. Individuals or partnerships who are non-citizens of Antigua and Barbuda, or who are not in possession of a valid work permit issued under the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code, or a company which is not incorporated under the laws of Antigua and Barbuda, or registered as an external company, and not in possession of a registration number issued by the Commissioner of Inland Revenue are not qualified for granting of a licence. Offenders can face a number of fines and penalties including imprisonment of up to 6 months if caught in the violation of the Trading Regulations.

Kindly take the necessary actions to ensure that your business is duly licensed.
